Restricting Canadian Oil Will Restrict Wisconsin Jobs



The Wisconsin Legislature is debating a bill that would establish a Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) in Wisconsin. The LCFS would restrict the use of Canadian crude oil, but many Wisconsin manufacturing jobs are tied directly to the Canadian oil industry. A LCFS is bad for Wisconsin because it will:

- ✓ Increase the price of gasoline in our state by as much as 60 cents per gallon*
- ✓ Threaten Wisconsin manufacturing jobs that supply the Canadian oil industry
- ✓ Create fuel supply shortages that could lead to gasoline rationing
- ✓ Make Wisconsin more dependent on oil from hostile countries in the Middle East
